6. Currency

The currency used in Chile is the peso (\$). The average exchange rate is 470 pesos to the U.S. dollar.

8. Transportation

There are special minibuses to transport the passengers from the airport to the different areas of the city. The best known are Transfer and Delfos. They carry 10-12 people with a value of approximately US\$ 10.00 per person. A normal taxi rate from the airport to ECLAC is about Ch\$ 14.000 (US\$ 20 to 25).

9. General Information on Santiago

Santiago, a city of about six million people, is the capital of the Republic of Chile. It has a Mediterranean climate and well-defined seasons, from rainy winters with temperatures as low as 0° C (May to September) to dry summers, when daytime temperatures hover around 30° C (November to March). The relative humidity is low. Springtime starts on September 21st, with temperatures from 20-25°C. June, July and August are cold and rainy months and it is advisable to bring warm clothes and umbrella.

The capital is one and a half hour from seaside resorts such as Viña del Mar. Cultural activity is at its peak from March to December and includes concerts, opera, theatre and historical and art museums. There are five local television channels. A wide variety of cable channels, such as CNN, HBO and MSTV, are also available.

Buses, taxis and three subway lines serve the city's transport needs. Taxi fares are metered and, in general, drivers do not accept tips.

It is suggested that visitors drink bottled mineral water, since tap water, although drinkable, sometimes affects those who are not accustomed to it.

Santiago is quite a safe place. However, like in other big cities, it is necessary to use common sense. It is advisable not to go downtown at night alone, to avoid badly illuminated or isolated streets and to be careful with expensive jewelry and handbags.

Helpful hints: Electric current in Chile is 220 volts, 50 cycles AC.

FACILITIES AND SERVICES AT ECLAC

Travel agency Flight reservations and confirmations and other travel formalities are

handled by the travel agency "Wagon Lits Cook", located on the

main floor of the ECLAC building (Z-324).

Restaurants ECLAC has a cafeteria, located on the third floor, which is open

from 8.45 a.m. until 5 p.m. The VIP Restaurant, on the fourth floor, is open from 12 noon until 2 p.m. Meals must be paid for directly by

the participants.

Medical Service The ECLAC Medical Service is available to participants requiring

medical assistance. It is located on the main floor (Z-210), telephone extension 2333, and is open from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and

from 2.30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Bank A branch of Banco de Chile is located on the first basement level. It

is open to the public from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. The local currency is the peso (\$), with bills of \$500, \$1.000, \$2.000, \$5.000, \$10.000 and \$20.000; and coins of \$1, \$5, \$10, \$50, \$100 and \$500. Foreign

currency may be changed from 10 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.

Mail There is a post office next to Banco de Chile which opens from

10.30 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Shops The "Anayhue Shop" offers gifts, crafts, newspapers, magazines

and other items. Provides photocopy service and fax at a cost of \$ 40 per page. It is located to the left of the main entrance to the

building and opens from 09:00 a.m. to 5.30 p.m.
